#### **Hello!**



#### **Event**

The tour takes place on June 5<sup>th</sup>- June 7<sup>th</sup>, and you are welcome to join all or just portions of the tour. We will arrive at Summer Lake Hot Springs between 3pm and 4pm on Monday June 5<sup>th</sup>, and meet at the Paisley Pioneer Saloon for dinner starting at 6 pm. We will spend all day Tuesday, June 6<sup>th</sup> touring Lake County clean energy projects and facilities. Wednesday morning there will be a breakfast round table on rural energy and new emerging community solar policy before we wrap up and head home. A full event program is attached.

#### **Location**

The tour starts at Summer Lake Hot Springs, and continues to Lakeview, Oregon. Addresses and lodging information listed below.
